
STRANGER THINGS

Stranger Things, created by the Duffer Brothers, has been a cultural phenomenon for the better part of a decade, growing from a nostalgic sci-fi mystery into one of the most defining television events of this generation. The long-awaited finale was finally released on Netflix, where our heroes united for a single goal: find and kill Vecna. Burdened with so many questions to answer, the final battle looms larger and darker than ever.



On a technical scale, the finale did deliver. The visual effects were genuinely impressive, and the climactic fighting sequence was a thrilling experience that kept my heart racing throughout. The production quality is consistently amazing, making every supernatural encounter feel both terrifying and cinematic. The cast gave outstanding performances, with moments that showed raw emotion and vulnerability, faithful to the character arcs that have been carefully developed throughout the series. These moments were built on years of shared history, trauma, loyalty, and love, which contributed to the emotional weight.



However, after such extensive buildup across the season, the final battle was disappointingly brief, and it felt a little too easy for our protagonists to defeat such powerful threats. Despite being a sci-fi series with alternate dimensions and impossible scenarios, the show lacked twists in how the resolution unfolded, which made it a little too predictable. Additionally, some scenes felt overly sentimental. While certain moments dragged, others felt rushed. It also left a considerable number of plot holes and questions unanswered, which isn't ideal when the point of a finale is to tie up those loose ends.

These issues could keep the series finale from achieving satisfying greatness, but they didn't prevent it from being both entertaining and impactful. While the two hours weren't perfect, it worked where it mattered most: it contained the horror, the humor, and the heart that defined *Stranger Things*, even after a final season that did not always feel steady. The epilogue gave the characters and the audience more than enough room to breathe, reflect, and say goodbye. It managed to provide something increasingly rare in modern television—closure. For fans who've followed these characters since they were kids riding bikes through Hawkins, that sense of completion matters. The series as a whole remains fun and incredible, and now that the entire saga is available without any need to wait, you should absolutely experience it if you haven't already.

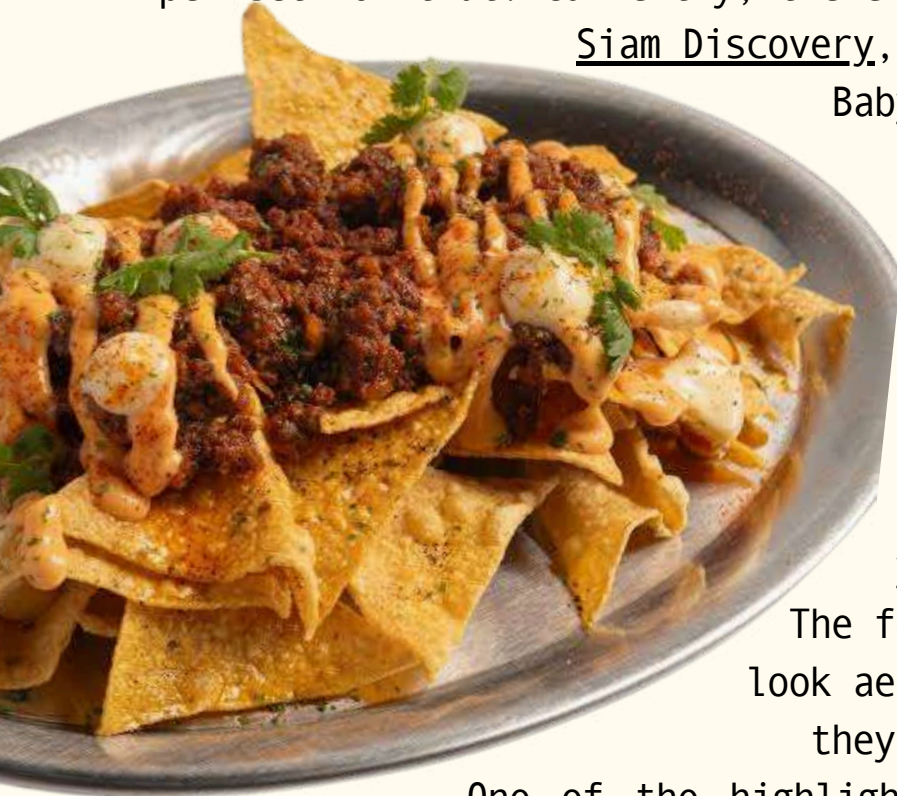
Dining Recommendation

If you're looking for a place to enjoy your meal and take pictures for social media, the restaurant Babyccino is perfect for that. Currently, there are three locations: at Siam Discovery, Ekkamai, and Mahanakhon.



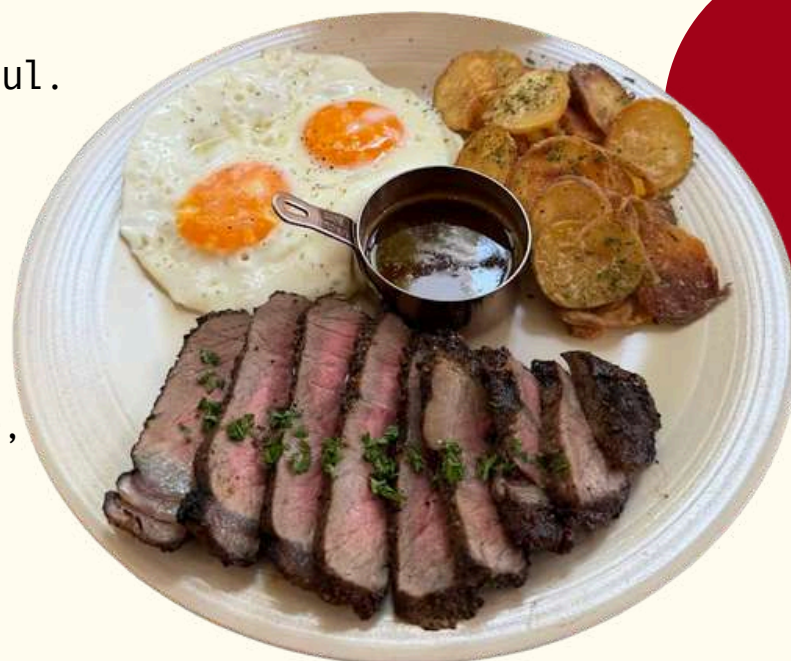
Babyccino is very modern and cozy, which is great for photos. Along with that, the food there is amazing. Whether you want to eat breakfast, lunch, dinner, or just have a little dessert, you can go there anytime.

The food and desserts not only look aesthetically pleasing, but they are also very delicious.

One of the highlights of Babyccino is its' variety of food. The menu offers a mix of Western-style dishes such as pasta, sandwiches, pancakes, and French toast. I personally prefer the brunch options at any time, especially the egg dishes and toast, which is simply flavorful.

I recommend the "Roast Beef Filet Flatbread."

It's a flatbread topped with many pieces of roast beef. On the side of the bread, it's sprinkled with shredded cheese, and in the middle is a creamy, milky cheese filling.



However, if you're looking for small plates to share with friends or family, I would recommend the "Homemade Potato Chips with Caviar and Mentaiko Dips." The potato chips are made in small circles. The chips are fried to a perfect crisp, and the caviar dip gives a creamy flavor while the mentaiko dip adds a bit of salty flavor. For those with a sweet tooth, the desserts pair well with the restaurant's coffee and drinks. If you like sour and sweet flavors, the lemon tart is perfect for you. The tart is crunchy, and the lemon paste is thick and perfectly balanced between sour and sweet.

The drinks are another strong point. Babyccino serves a variety of coffee, tea, milkshakes, and refreshing beverages that complement the food nicely. One drink that I would recommend is the "Lotus Biscoff" milkshake. It has a nice, thick texture with milky sweetness along with the

flavor of Biscoff syrup. On top of that, there are small chunks of Biscoff in it, which make the drink complete.

Cooking Recipe

Broccoli Parmesan Chips Recipe

Tired of unhealthy, greasy chips but still want something crunchy and delicious? These smashed broccoli parmesan chips are the perfect healthier swap. They're crispy, cheesy, and full of flavor without all the guilt.

Even better, they use less than 10 ingredients and take only about 20 minutes to make. Made with simple ingredients, these chips are easy to prepare and full of cheesy flavor. Once baked, they turn golden and crunchy, making them a fun snack, side dish, or even lunchbox treat. Healthy never tasted this good! So turn on some music and let's start! (Feel good cooking mix on Spotify)!

Ingredients

- 2 heads of broccoli
- 3/4 cup shredded parmesan cheese
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- 1/2 tsp onion powder
- 1/4 tsp Italian seasoning
- Salt
- Black pepper

Instructions

- Preheat the oven to 400°F (about 200°C).
- Air fryer alternative: just place the broccoli in when you're ready to cook.
- Cut the broccoli crowns into individual florets.
- Bring a large pot of water to a boil. Once boiling, add the broccoli florets.
- Cook for 3-5 minutes, then drain the broccoli.
- Run the broccoli under cold water to stop the cooking process.
- Thoroughly pat the broccoli dry.

- In a small bowl, combine olive oil, garlic powder, onion powder, and Italian seasoning.
- Grease a large baking sheet well, then spread the broccoli florets on it.

- Smash each floret with a glass jar or heavy object until flattened
- Brush or spoon the olive oil mixture over each smashed floret.
- Top each one with parmesan cheese.
- Season with salt and black pepper.
- Bake for 10-15 minutes, or until the cheese is melted and the broccoli is crispy to your liking.

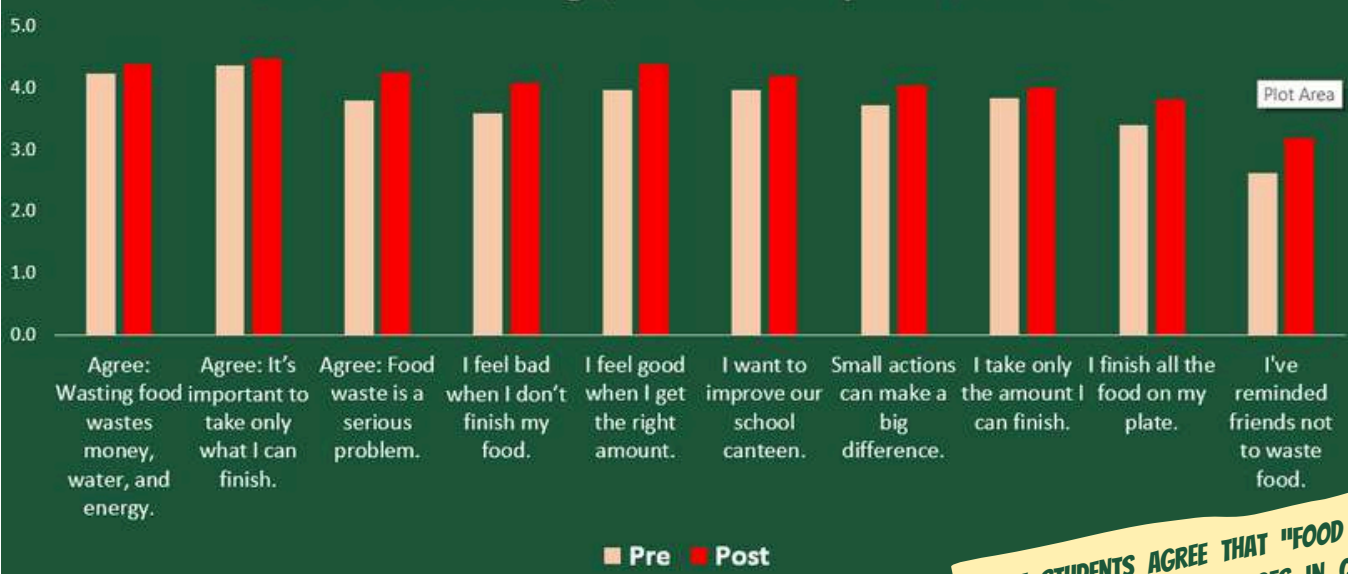

SENIOR PROJECT PACE

Parkinson's disease is a progressive neurological disorder that affects movement, with Freezing of Gait (FoG) being one of its most disabling symptoms. It is caused by the lack of dopamine producing nerve cells (neurons), impacting muscle control. FoG causes sudden interruptions in walking, typically a few seconds, which increases the risk of falls and reduces a patient's independence.



Although FoG can't be "cured" completely, it can generally be treated by physical therapy, Deep Brain Stimulation (to manage symptoms for extreme cases), and levodopa medication (adjust dopamine levels). It can also be treated by applying walking aids, such as visual and audio cues. However, they do not fully restore control over walking.



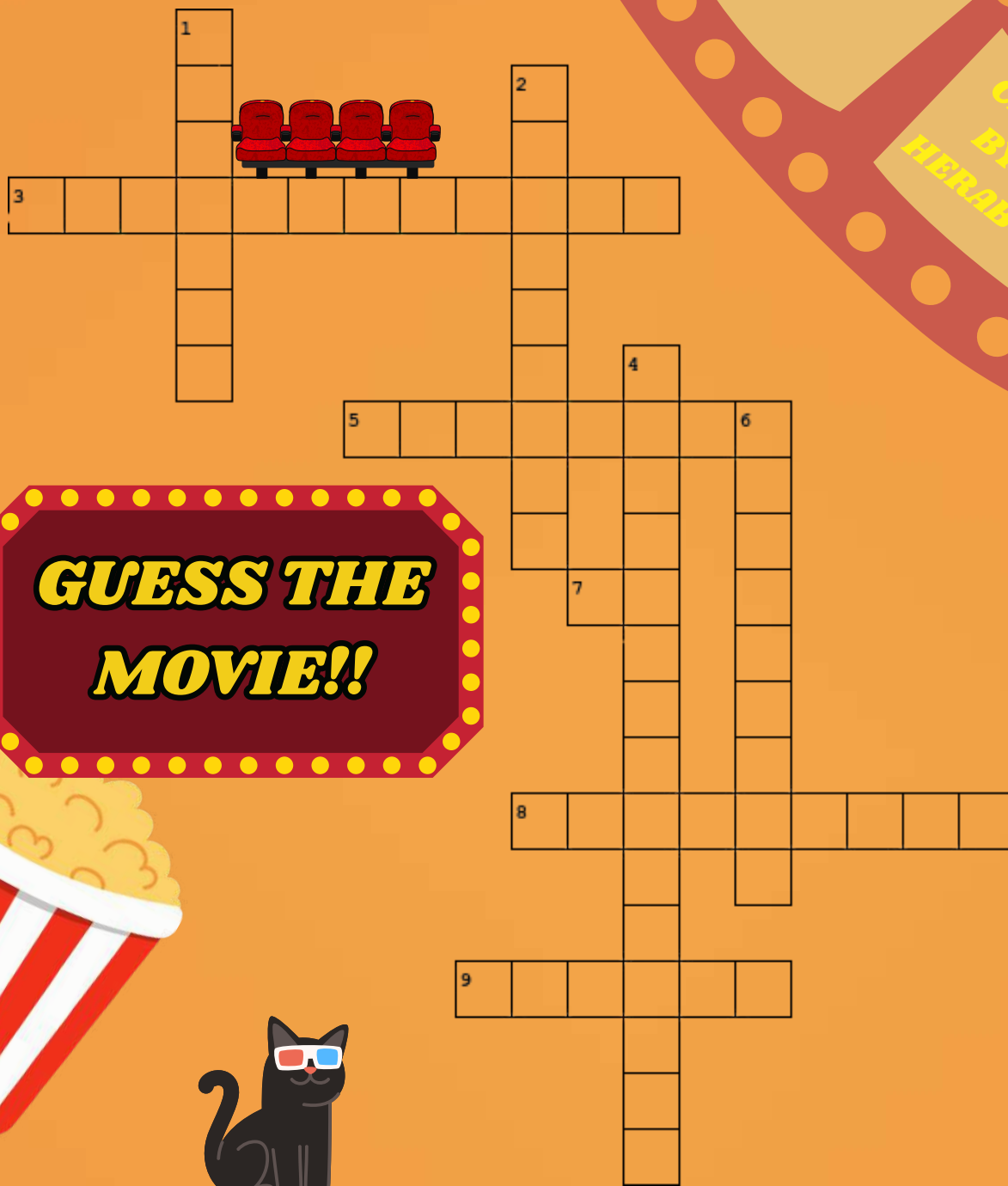
This senior project, Pace, was inspired by observing the real-life challenges faced by individuals with Parkinson's disease and the limitations of existing treatments. It explores how wearable assistive technology can provide practical support in daily life. By combining visual and vibration cues in a shoe-based design, the project aims to help users overcome freezing episodes, enhance confidence and independence, and improve walking control.



Two conditions were tested:
Walking with regular shoes
Walking with the improved walking shoes

The same distance was used for both trials. Time was recorded using a stopwatch. The results showed that the patients took 10 seconds less to walk a certain distance with improved shoes, compared to regular shoes.
